<u>EMERGENCY RESPONSE LOCKER GUIDELINES</u>

Thank you for your purchase of the Emergency Response Locker. Due to the numerous types of building material and building codes throughout the United States of America the following guidelines for mounting are suggested from Jersey Tactical Corp.

- Location of the locker should be decided by the customer.
- The locker should be mounted in accordance with your local building codes and by a professional in the construction industry.
- The location is the choice of the owner. Jersey Tactical Corp. suggests mounting them in highly visible and high traffic areas.
- It is suggested to mount them in view of your CCTV (closed circuit tv) system in order to prevent attempted vandalism and or theft attempts.
- If mounting outside it is suggested that the locker be mounted in a well light location and monitored by one of the CCTV of your campus.
- The locker is made from a heavy gauge steel and is one that will allow your installer to drill holes in accordance to where, what type of mounting hardware, and how many they decide to use to mount the locker.
- Jersey Tactical Corp suggests using stainless steel bolts and or screws for the application. In addition to this the bolt or screws should also be used with washers in order to provide a larger supported area for the mounting of the locker and distribution of the locker's total weight.
- The size, type and how many pieces of mounting hardware is up to the installer as they will know exactly what the customer will be mounting in all of these lockers and the total weight of the lockers and when they have everything

the customer adds to them post buying them from Jersey Tactical Corp.

- When mounting the locker the installer wants to ensure that the door to the locker will have enough clearance from a corner or hip wall and other obstructions in order to open past a 90 degree angle. This is to ensure that in an emergency mass access without delay can occur. It is suggested that 180 degree angle of door opening is the best option for the safest access to the locker in an emergency.
- The Emergency Response Locker will be shipped with the Emergency Response Locker Stickers separately. The customer can decide to attach the stickers to the outside of the locker or not. The customer can also attach the stickers to different doors/windows as indicators that the school/building/train platform/ etc. is equipped with the Emergency Response Lockers for Active Shooter/Emergency Response.
- The customer should be aware that some of the products in the locker contain an expiration date. It is the customer's responsibility to know the expiration dates and to replace expired products. A few examples would be the contents of the bleeding control kit or if the locker contained a ballistic shield.
- Jersey Tactical Corp. assumes no liability for the mounting of lockers, location of lockers, security of the lockers and use of the lockers. All risks associated with such are of that of the customer and Jersey Tactical Corp shall be deemed hold harmless in the event of any claims.
