

AT EASE Foundation to Donate Lifesaving Devices to Protect Hunterdon County Schools

Lebanon Township, NJ – At the October 10th Hunterdon County Crime Stoppers event <u>AT EASE</u> <u>Foundation</u> proposed donating lifesaving devices to seven Hunterdon County Schools and their associated police departments. The offer was readily accepted. The nonprofit organization will present an Emergency Response Locker to each of the designated schools and Jersey Claws to the police departments.

Developed by Jersey Tactical Corp., the <u>Emergency Response Locker</u> contains 1 Claw (patented breaching tool), a Claw Go Sling, a Purchase Point Wedge and a stop the bleed kit. (Additional equipment can be added, including ballistic shields and floor plans.)

The Jersey Tactical Claw is fast becoming a must-have tool for emergency responders who need to breach doors in case of active shooter events, fires and more. Developed by Lopatcong-based Jersey Tactical, the company's slogan touts the Claw's benefits for first responders: "If you can't get in you can't save anyone." Jersey Tactical Corp has offered to do free training on use of their devices.
